21/11/15 07:35	<p>2 further episodes of sudden desats (to unrecordable levels) at 06:56 and at 07:24 + bradycardia. Both associated with clenching of hands, stiff limbs (upper > lower) and, on 2nd occasion, eyes deviated to left. Stiffness took 10 mins to settle on first occasion, 3-4 mins on second occasion. Needed urgent ventilation - 20 mins first occasion, 5 mins on 2nd. Perfusion poor during first episode until 20 ml/kg saline given after 14 mins. For entry equal, abdo not distended. Post each episode - perfusion satisfactory, cap upl, 1-2 secs (central + peripheral). Bld glucose 9 during 2nd episode. No electrolyte abnormalities on ABG earlier in night (altno, $K^+ = 3.0$), Ca^{2+} normal on bloods on 24/11/15.</p> <p><u>Impression</u> Seizures Septic</p> <p><u>Plan:</u> - 1L IV loading phenobarbitone - for 1L 10% glucose + ABG - for 1L cefotaxime + teicoplanin - CXR + AXR - talk to surgeons later (about Xrays) - LFTs latest - UTS head</p> <p>PD GIBB C. 	<p>Asked to attend immediately as Child J gone blue</p> <p>Apparently Crying → picked by SW bagles was blue + crying → went pale.</p> <p>IPPRV started</p> <p>HR about 40 on the monitor. Cardiac Compressions started. But always breaking for herself although laboured</p> <p>On my arrival about 2 mins later</p> <p>Child J being bagged</p> <p>looks pale / floppy</p> <p>crying under mask</p> <p>HR 46 on monitor</p> <p>On Auscultation >100/min</p> <p>Colour marginally better but pale</p> <p>CRT 3-4 sec.</p> <p>Spontaneous breathing → sent 100% in O₂</p> <p>Transferred to Nursing I via facial mask in incubator.</p>
