PD 14/16 Written at 1740	<p>5 MURRAY lost blood</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Crash call at 16-04, arrived on scene 1615 - 33/40 turn 2 - cardioresp arrest - Stable through day - Slight abdominal distension + 9 NO aspirates - At 16-02, abdominal distension 9 aspirates - Desaturation & bradycardia then corrected - CPR started immediately - Intubated by Dr (Hobbs, reg) at 10 mins - When intubated, adrenaline x 3 given (0.18mls / 1.10000) + NaHCO₃ 3.5mls - Bilious no aspirates, abdo distended - No spinal signs, HR 60. Good aetiology - CPR continued - Required 3 more doses adrenaline, 1 more NaHCO₃ - 2 x 10ml 0.9% saline - At 20 mins At 1631 HR > 100 + gasps - S/W Parents explained that sudden collapse led to arrest but no obvious cause. Could be due to infection or abdominal problem. - Explained that due to arrest, potential problems with kidney function, blood pressure & seizures & will need close observation. - Blood gas at 20 mins into arrest → pH 7.00 pCO₂ 10.6 HCO₃ 13.7 S/GS -13.3 lactate 9.8 Glucose 6.0
