Thank you for your letter of 23 December 2015.

Your further submissions have been very helpful and I have decided, on reflection, not to discontinue the investigation but to hold a full Inquest into the death of **Child D**.

During the course of your letter you submit that the evidence suggests that had different courses of treatment been employed, child b s death would probably have been avoided. That in my view overstates the existing evidence which suggests only that death might have been avoided. However, I am now satisfied that this is an area that needs to be explored in detail at a full Inquest and my intention is to instruct an independent gynaecologist and an independent paediatrician. The gynaecologist will be able to give expert evidence as regard to the treatment of Mother D and the paediatrician will be able to give expert evidence with regard to the treatment of child D

It will, I am afraid, take a little time to obtain experts reports but I will list a full Inquest hearing as soon as possible.

I am contacting the hospital to inform them of my decision.
