The post-mortem reports disclose a naturally occurring death and I am discontinuing the investigations. There is nothing in the reports to indicate any clinical mismanagement in relation to these deaths which were both sudden and unexpected. It can be seen that Dr Kokai ascribes the deaths to prematurity albeit the processes which occurred in each case were different.

I am aware of the investigation that you refer to. The Hospital itself called for an investigation by dint of the fact that they had experienced a number of peri-natal deaths in excess of what they might have statistically expected. The investigation was not instituted because of specific concerns about the deaths in this instance and as noted above I know of no clinical mismanagement.
