<p>Chester Number of mortalities: 1</p>	<p>Day PD transferred to CoCH on CPAP. 1 month of age: abdo distension and desat/bradys – ventilated and transferred to LWH for surgical review. LWH: NEC treated conservatively. CRP rose on antibiotics and teicoplanin added. Transferred to Coch after 7 days. Next month in CoCH: problems with feed tolerance, full abdomen. Bradycardia and desats – cef and met. Ongoing discussion with surgical team and LWH consultants. Arrests on 13th, 14th and 15th Oct. Eventual transfer to APH. Returned to CoCH on 17th Oct after extubation, change of antibiotics, but no surgical review. 23rd Oct – further arrest and unsuccessful resus. Lessons Learned: For discussion regarding transfer of sick preterm babies across network.? Need for Network antibiotic policy</p>
