I have spoken to staff on delivery suite regarding cord clamping. Unless the baby requires immediate resuscitation or there is another contraindication, it is usual practice to delay cord clamping for 2 minutes following delivery by C/S. The air conditioning in theatre is turned off prior to the delivery of the baby and the baby is wrapped in a large gauze swab or a towel for warmth during this time.
