Child E	<p>This was a spontaneous twin pregnancy (monochorionic, diamniotic) with complications of twin 1. In-utero transfer was arranged at 29+5 weeks gestation to Countess of Chester Hospital due to no capacity in Liverpool Womens Hospital NNU. There was a deterioration in the condition of twin 1 and delivery by c-section was agreed.</p> <p>Born prematurely at 29+5 twin 1, was at high risk of subsequent bowel problems due to his prematurity, absent end diastolic flow and IUGR. Gastrointestinal haemorrhage, discoloured abdomen and cardiovascular collapse on PD of life. Clinically diagnosed with Necrotising Enterocolitis (NEC). Rapid deterioration lead to cardiorespiratory event despite fluid resuscitation, antibiotics, intubation and ventilation. Prolonged resuscitation was unsuccessful and he sadly died in parents arms.</p>
