5	<p>Local QSG meeting summaries</p> <p>The Local QSG meeting summary reports circulated with the minutes were noted (Item 5a). Additional intelligence was reported by exception and is noted under the following categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Action – new/emerging quality issues requiring regional attention or action Sharing – issues of wider regional interest shared for learning and enhanced understanding <p>Individual stakeholders also provided supporting information as part of discussion by exception.</p> <p>Cheshire and Merseyside</p> <p>The Cheshire and Merseyside summary (Item 5b) covering the Cheshire, Warrington and Wirral QSG and the Merseyside QSG that was circulated with the agenda was noted. LC highlighted the following information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>The Countess of Chester Hospital</u> Sharing: There are plans in place to downgrade three neonatal intensive care cots to Level 1, whilst a comprehensive investigation is carried out. A Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health (RCPCH) Review was carried out from 01 - 02 September 2016 which went well and therefore it has been agreed that the level of surveillance should be downgraded to 'routine.' <u>Bridgewater Community Health NHS Foundation Trust</u> Sharing: A review of quality and governance by NHS Halton CCG and NHS St Helens CCG found that the two CCGs did not agree on the outcome. At the Merseyside QSG meeting it was agreed that a QRP would be completed to review all concerns and consider next steps as required. This was due for completion 31 August 2016. <u>BPAS – NHS Halton CCG Report</u> Sharing: A Thematic Review was undertaken of BPAS services, following five SIs, which occurred between October 2015 and March 2016 in Liverpool. NHS Halton CCG led the review and found that there was nothing of concern. <u>Liverpool Community Health NHS Trust</u> Sharing: GH confirmed that a clinical review will take place. ToR have been drafted and Rosie Turner (RT) is currently reviewing them. <u>Royal Liverpool and Broadgreen University Hospitals NHS Trust</u> Sharing: Once the new hospital is built, there will be a reduction in beds.
