1 Safe

- No Never Events or Serious Incidents have been reported by the trust between November 14 and October 15
- No Pressure ulcers, Falls or C.UTI's were reported between September 14 and September 15
- All questions in the Children's survey relating to the Safe domain were about the same as other trusts.
- The staff skill mix shows the proportion of Consultants and Junior level grades is lower than the England average.

2 Effective

- All questions in the Children's survey relating to the Effective domain are about the same as other trusts.
- The Paediatric Diabetes audit 2014/15 shows the share Hb1AC <7.5% is higher than the England average which indicates more people have controlled diabetes which is a positive factor whereas ,for the mean result, a higher number as stated indicates less people have controlled diabetes which is negative.
- The emergency readmission rate at trust level for all non-elective is higher than the England average
- The rate of multiple (two or more) emergency admissions within 12 months for Asthma 1-17 years is lower than the England average and Diabetes 1-17 years is higher than the England average.
