Straight from university I worked at Southampton hospital for a year as an adult nurse on a male brain surgical unit. I moved over to their neonatal unit and underwent their specialist neonatal nursing course during my time there. I left in April 2015 and acquired a job at Chester on the neonatal unit and worked there until around April 2020 when covid hit. I came up a permanent to go on the bank however as covid came, I asked for my job back and was refused as no space so i went to work on kids ward and worked there up until March 2022 and have since focused on other areas in life.

Band 5- neonatal nurse- looking after premature babies- assisting the doctors with their duties such as chest drain insertion-cannulations. Bottle fed. Looked after vented and Cpap babies. All round duties of a neonatal nurse

I think there should be one person in the room at all times- just going back to my Southampton days- even in special care with the babies that are getting ready to go home there would always be someone in the room just incase something happened with one of the babies.
