Hi Caroline and Nim,  
We have undertaken a review of Child I care who sadly died in October here.  
I have attached the relevant review documents and presentation.  
She was transferred 5 times between Chester, LWH and APH before she died and I think her care ought to be reviewed by these centres and the surgical team. We are still waiting for the coroner's PM report which might inform us further but I don't think so many transfers helped her care at all. Parents have spoken to the consultant here since her death and feel the same way.  
I was wondering whether the different teams could review their own contribution to her care before we discuss it at the next network mortality review? I think there is also a surgical mortality review in Liverpool which might also be appropriate?
