Hi Ruth,
I have attached the most recent version of the thematic review with embedded documents for each baby's review.

In addition, I have attached the reviews of the 3 deaths in Jan, Feb and March this year. Officially, I&S was not our mortality as he died at LWH. However he deteriorated here and died shortly after arrival there so we undertook a full review.

Other babies who have deteriorated unexpectedly this year since the review have been:

- I&S – acute deterioration requiring ventilation day PD. Badger discharge letter attached.
- Child M – acute deterioration requiring CPR and adrenaline, no cause identified. Badger discharge letter attached.
- Child K – 25 week gestation baby transferred to APH due to gestation at birth. Deterioration on ventilator whilst waiting for transfer. Died at APH. Badger discharge letter attached.
- Children O&P&R, Child O and Child P from last week.
- Child Q – acute deterioration requiring ventilation. Abdominal distension. Transferred to Alder Hey for review. No abnormalities detected there and transferred back to CoCH this week. Badger discharge letter attached.
