


Any information that you provide me with will form part of my investigation into this matter and ultimately may be presented in a Disciplinary Hearing, should this be necessary. I would advise you that you are entitled to be accompanied to this meeting by a Staff Organisation / Trade Union representative or workplace colleague. I enclose a second copy of this letter for you to give to your representative, if you so wish.

I also need to inform you that this is a confidential matter and should not be discussed with others unless they are your chosen representative or a formal part of the investigation team. Failure to adhere to this instruction could lead to disciplinary action being taken against you.

I recognise that this may be a difficult time for you and therefore, if you feel it would help, you are welcome to get in touch with the Staff Support Service via Occupational Health on ext . Their role is to offer confidential welfare support or advice in regard to your personal circumstances. You are, of course, welcome to contact the HR Specialist Team for procedural advice via 01 .
