THIRLWALL INQUIRY

WITNESS STATEMENT OF CHRIS DZIKITI

I, Chris Dzikiti, will say as follows: -

1. I am employed by the Care Quality Commission (CQC) as Interim Chief Inspector of Healthcare, a post I started in May 2024. Prior to this I was CQC's Director of Mental

Health, joining CQC in October 2022.

2. I have a background in Health Care, having qualified as a registered mental health nurse

in 2002. Between 2002 and 2013 I worked and managed mental health services in London

followed by working for a commissioning team at NHS England. In 2017 I joined an Integrated Care System in London leading on mental health transformation and returned

to NHS England in 2019 as Deputy Director of national retention programme. Between

2017 and 2021 I also worked as a global healthcare consultant for Health Education

England in India.

3. This statement is intended to provide the Inquiry with an update on CQC's position for

providing oral evidence to the Inquiry, currently scheduled to take place in January 2025.

Provision of Statements to the Inquiry

4. On the 6 November 2023, CQC received a request from the Thirlwall Inquiry made under

Rule 9 of the Inquiry Rules 2006. In response to the request, two statements were

submitted by In Trenholm, CQC's then Chief Executive. Those statements were dated 12

February 2024 and 4 April 2024.

5. On the 25 June 2024, Ian Trenholm announced he was to step down as Chief Executive

for CQC at the end of June 2024. Since that point CQC has had two Interim Chief

Executives in Kate Terroni and James Bullion, until the arrival of our current Chief

Executive Sir Julian Hartley on the 2 December 2024.

6. Further detail on CQC's change in leadership throughout this time was provided to the

Inquiry via an additional statement dated 24 October 2024.

7. As a member of CQC's executive team, I have been briefed by colleagues across the

organisation on our engagement with the Thirlwall Inquiry so far, including the matters

discussed with witnesses during oral hearings on the 14 and 15 November 2024.

8. I have been briefed on Ian Trenholm's previous statements to the Inquiry and the content

of these and will be familiarising myself further with those statements over the coming

weeks.

9. I can confirm to the Inquiry that I am able to adopt the statements of Ian Trenholm and

speak to the matters contained within those statements on behalf of CQC. Because I joined

the CQC in October 2022, much of what is set out in these statements is based on the

documentation available to me rather than being within my own direct knowledge.
